HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.236

Rep. Kahle offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare February 23, 2022, as Scoliosis 2 Screening Awareness Day in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, It is important to increase the public's awareness of scoliosis and help children, parents, adults, and health care 4 providers understand, recognize, and treat the complexities of 5 spinal deformities such as scoliosis; and 6 7 Whereas, Scoliosis, an abnormal curvature of the spine, is a 8 condition affecting an estimated six to nine million Americans, and can strike regardless of gender, race, age, or economic status; and 9 Whereas, Scoliosis patients make more than 600,000 visits to 10 health providers yearly, with approximately 30% of patients 11 12 requiring bracing, and 10% requiring surgery; and

Whereas, The primary age of onset for scoliosis is between ten 1 2 and 15 years old, with females being up to eight times more likely to progress to a curve magnitude that would require treatment; and 3 Whereas, Screening programs are quick, unobtrusive, and allow 4 for early detection and treatment opportunities which may alleviate 5 the worst effects of the condition; and 6 7 Whereas, This day is designated to raise awareness of 8 scoliosis screening, provide support to those who are diagnosed 9 with this condition, and to recognize the need for increased 10 research and funding to improve treatment; now, therefore, be it 11 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 12 this legislative body declare February 23, 2022, as Scoliosis Screening Awareness Day in Michigan. 13
