HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.309

Reps. Hoitenga, Outman, Griffin, LaFave, Markkanen, Borton, Carra, Steven Johnson, Meerman, Fink and Clements offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to urge the federal government to withdraw
- 2 membership in the World Health Organization and suspend all
- 3 payments to the organization.
- 4 Whereas, The United States government has historically been
- 5 one of the largest funders of the World Health Organization,
- 6 providing between \$200 million and \$600 million annually over the
- 7 last decade. These contributions have exceeded membership
- 8 contributions to include voluntary contributions. Voluntary
- 9 contributions are made of funds that could be redirected to
- 10 actually help Americans; and
- 11 Whereas, The World Health Organization was unable to

- 1 successfully manage the COVID-19 pandemic. The organization
- 2 recommended lockdowns, mandates, and vaccine passports, none of
- 3 which have stopped the spread of the COVID-19 virus. We cannot
- 4 continue to place our trust or our hard-earned taxpayer dollars in
- 5 the hands of the World Health Organization; and
- 6 Whereas, The World Health Assembly, comprised of
- 7 representatives from the World Health Organization's 194 member
- 8 states, is poised to vote on the Biden Administration's proposed
- 9 amendments to the International Health Regulations. These proposed
- 10 amendments would strengthen the World Health Organization's ability
- 11 to declare health emergencies without the consent of State parties;

- 13 Whereas, These proposed amendments raise significant concerns
- 14 regarding our country's sovereignty. Without consent from the
- 15 United States, the declaration of an international health emergency
- 16 may cause undue economic and financial actions by other nations,
- 17 ostracism, or other negative consequences; now, therefore, be it
- 18 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we urge the
- 19 federal government to withdraw membership in the World Health
- 20 Organization and suspend all payments to the organization; and be
- 21 it further
- 22 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 23 President of the United States of America, the Speaker of the
- 24 United States House of Representatives, the President of the United
- 25 States Senate, and members of the Michigan congressional
- 26 delegation.
