HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.315

Rep. Manoogian offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to call upon the Russian Federation to respect
- 2 the human and legal rights of and to immediately release two-time
- 3 Olympic gold medalist and American professional basketball player
- 4 Brittney Griner from detention in the Russian Federation and urge
- 5 President Joe Biden to make her safe return to the United States a
- 6 priority for his Administration.
- 7 Whereas, On February 17, 2022, American professional
- 8 basketball player Brittney Griner, a U.S. citizen, two-time Olympic
- 9 gold medalist for Team USA, NCAA Champion for Baylor University,
- 10 and seven-time WNBA All Star center for the Phoenix Mercury, was
- 11 detained at the Sheremetyevo airport near Moscow, Russia, as she
- 12 attempted to board a flight while playing for the Russian
- 13 professional basketball team, UMMC Ekaterinburg, a team she has

- 1 led to four Euroleague Titles and seven Russian League
- 2 Championships during the WNBA offseason; and
- 3 Whereas, The Russian Federation failed to announce their
- 4 detention of Brittney Griner until March 5, 2022, more than two
- 5 weeks after the Russian Federal Customs Service had detained her.
- 6 American consular officials were unable to see her until April 27,
- 7 2022, more than two months after her detention; and
- 8 Whereas, Brittney Griner has been detained for nearly three
- 9 months, and a Russian court extended her detention by one month and
- 10 has denied appeals from her legal team to have her transferred to
- 11 house arrest; and
- 12 Whereas, There have been multiple reports by U.S. authorities
- 13 that Brittney Griner has been denied consular assistance, which is
- 14 an essential component of normal diplomatic relations between two
- 15 nation states; and
- Whereas, On May 2, 2022, the United States Department of State
- 17 emailed a statement to ESPN stating that they have determined that
- 18 the Russian Federation has wrongfully detained Brittney Griner; and
- 19 Whereas, The WNBA issued a statement saying that Brittney
- 20 Griner "has the WNBA's full support and our main priority is her
- 21 swift and safe return to the United States." This season, the WNBA
- 22 has emblazoned the league's 12 basketball courts with Brittney
- 23 Griner's initials and her number, 42; and
- 24 Whereas, The State Department is monitoring the situation, but
- 25 more can be done to secure Brittney Griner's release. She is a
- 26 global sport icon who engages the world as a track II diplomat
- 27 through her leadership on and off the court with Team USA at the
- 28 Olympic Games and in FIBA. She uses the game of basketball both in
- 29 the United States as a WNBA star for the Phoenix Mercury and abroad

- 1 to promote inclusion and understanding. It is morally unacceptable
- 2 that Brittney Griner is being used by the Russian government as a
- 3 political pawn; now, therefore, be it
- 4 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we call upon
- 5 the Russian Federation to immediately release two-time Olympic gold
- 6 medalist and American professional basketball player Brittney
- 7 Griner; and be it further
- 8 Resolved, That we urge the Russian Federation to provide
- 9 consular access to Brittney Griner while she remains in detention;
- 10 and be it further
- 11 Resolved, That we urge the Russian Federation to respect the
- 12 human rights of Brittney Griner; and be it further
- 13 Resolved, That we urge President Joe Biden to make Brittney
- 14 Griner's safe return a top priority for his Administration; and be
- 15 it further
- 16 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 17 President of the United States, the United States Secretary of
- 18 State, and the Griner family.
