## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.322

Rep. Sneller offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to recognize June 28-July 3, 2022, as Lesbian, 2 Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Queer (LGBTQ) Pride Week in the 3 state of Michigan. 4 Whereas, Pride began 52 years ago in 1970 with the one year anniversary of the Stonewall Riots. In 1969, a black trans woman 5 6 named Marsha P. Johnson, along with other LGBTQ individuals, risked 7 their lives to protest the over-policing of the LGBTQ community and 8 the injustice that threatened their existence on a daily basis. 9 This multi-day protest became known as the Stonewall Riots and is credited by many for starting the modern-day LGBTQ equality 10 11 movement; and 12 Whereas, The LGBTQ movement has endured through tragedy and struggle, including the slow and insufficient government response 13

- 1 to assist those with HIV/AIDS and the ongoing effort today to
- 2 protect the rights of the LGBTQ community; and
- 3 Whereas, The movement has also celebrated victories of
- 4 recognition, especially the historic Obergefell v. Hodges decision
- 5 in 2015 which affirmed marriage equality nationwide and the recent
- 6 Bostock v. Clayton County decision in 2020 that upheld federal
- 7 employment protections for the LGBTQ community; and
- 8 Whereas, Everyone in Michigan benefits from the multiple
- 9 talents, viewpoints, and cultural backgrounds of all of its
- 10 residents and from preserving the freedom, worth, and dignity of
- 11 those in the LGBTQ community; and
- 12 Whereas, Michigan should expend all efforts to attract and
- 13 retain talent and signal to the nation we are welcoming to all
- 14 those who wish to contribute to the economic vitality of our state;

- 16 Whereas, The people of Michigan understand, appreciate, and
- 17 value the cultural, civic, and economic contributions of the LGBTQ
- 18 communities to the greater community of the state and affirm a
- 19 celebration of love, living authentically, and accepting ourselves;

- 21 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 22 this legislative body recognize June 28-July 3, 2022, as Lesbian,
- 23 Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Queer (LGBTQ) Pride Week in the
