Harris offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare September 2022 as Big Brothers Big 2 Sisters Youth Mentoring Month in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, There are thousands of children living in poverty throughout the state of Michigan; and 4 Whereas, Growing up in poverty and experiencing other adverse 5 childhood experiences significantly reduces a child's chances for 6 7 success; and Whereas, Children thrive when under the influence of a one-to-8 9 one mentoring relationship with an adult; and Whereas, Big Brothers Big Sisters agencies have helped 10 hundreds of thousands of young people successfully navigate life's 11 12 challenges and achieve success through fostering one-to-one

- 2 Whereas, The need for mentoring relationships continues to
- 3 grow statewide, with statistics showing a need for thousands of
- 4 youth in need of adult mentors; and
- 5 Whereas, Volunteer mentors provide their mentees with a safe
- 6 place and support network to help at-risk youth reach their full
- 7 potential; and
- 8 Whereas, The Big Brothers Big Sisters agencies in the state of
- 9 Michigan have recently formed the Big Brothers Big Sisters Alliance
- 10 of Michigan to increase resources and create opportunities that
- 11 sustain and grow program services across the state; and
- 12 Whereas, Youth with mentors are less likely to skip school,
- 13 use alcohol and drugs, drop out of school, and are more likely to
- 14 reach a higher level of education, be financially literate, find a
- 15 full-time job or career, volunteer in the community, and lead a
- 16 healthy lifestyle; and
- 17 Whereas, The Big Brothers Big Sisters Alliance of Michigan
- 18 believes in changing outcomes for Michigan's at-risk youth and
- 19 reversing the downward spiral brought on by poverty and adverse
- 20 childhood experiences by fostering one-to-one mentoring
- 21 relationships, and
- 22 Whereas, The House of Representatives is committed to helping
- 23 Michigan's children find success throughout their academics and
- 24 careers; now, therefore, be it
- 25 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That members of the
- 26 legislative body declare September 2022 as Big Brothers Big Sisters
- 27 Youth Mentoring Month in the state of Michigan.
