Haadsma offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare October 2022 as Disability Employment 2 Awareness Month in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, The percentage of adults with a disability in Michigan is 29% of the population or 1 in 3 adults and roughly 4 66.2% are unemployed; and Whereas, People with disabilities in Michigan share with the 6 7 rest of the state's nearly 10 million residents the right to work 8 in competitive integrated work environments with needed supports; 9 and 10 Whereas, Disabled people make up the largest minority group in the world. Yet, our schools, businesses, government, and 11
