

## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.367

The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

1           A resolution of tribute to for the Honorable Sue Allor.

2           Whereas, It is with gratitude that we recognize Representative  
3 Sue Allor for her work on behalf of the citizens of Michigan and,  
4 in particular, her constituents in the One Hundred-sixth District.  
5 Throughout her tenure in the House, Representative Allor's hard  
6 work has benefited not only the people of Alcona County, Alpena  
7 County, Iosco County, Presque Isle County, and parts of Cheboygan  
8 County, including the townships of Aloha, Benton, Burt, Ellis,  
9 Forest, Grant, Inverness, Mentor, Mullett, Nunda, Walker, Waverly,

12 2016, Representative Allor drew on her personal experiences to  
13 become an advocate for the hardworking people of the One Hundred-  
14 sixth District. She served with distinction as chair of the  
15 Appropriations subcommittees for Natural Resources and  
16 Environmental Quality, and Agriculture and Rural Development. She  
17 also served as vice chair of the Appropriations subcommittee on  
18 Health and Human Services. Representative Allor served as a member  
19 of the House committees on Health Policy; and Appropriations  
20 subcommittees for General Government, Military and Veteran Affairs,  
21 Transportation, and School Aid and Education. Her dedication and
