

## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.406

The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

1           A resolution of tribute for the Honorable Steve Marino.

2           Whereas, It is with gratitude that we recognize Representative  
3 Steve Marino for his work on behalf of the citizens of Michigan  
4 and, in particular, his constituents in the Twenty-fourth District.  
5 Throughout his tenure in the House, Representative Marino's hard  
6 work has benefited not only the people of Harrison Township,  
7 Clinton Township, and Macomb Township, but all of Michigan's  
8 citizens; and

9           Whereas, Born in Detroit, Representative Marino's life  
10 experiences reflect his ability to represent Michigan's diverse  
11 citizenry. He holds bachelor's degrees in economics, public policy  
12 and public administration, and political theory and constitutional

1 democracy from Michigan State University, where he was also student  
2 body president. Before joining the Legislature, Representative  
3 Marino applied his expertise through his work as a Macomb County  
4 Commissioner and a small business owner of a public affairs firm.  
5 He has remained active in his community as well, currently serving  
6 on the Macomb County Chamber of Commerce's Public Policy and  
7 Military Affairs committees as well as previously serving on the  
8 Macomb Health Department Hearing Board and Harrison Township Zoning  
9 Board; and

10       Whereas, Since his election to the House of Representatives in  
11 2016, Representative Marino has demonstrated a deep commitment to  
12 improving the lives of his constituents in the Twenty-fourth  
13 District. He served with distinction as the chair of the Commerce  
14 and Tourism Committee and as the vice chair of the Local Government  
15 and Municipal Finance Committee and the Appropriations  
16 subcommittees on Community Colleges and State Police.  
17 Representative Marino was also a member of the Appropriations  
18 subcommittees on Joint Capital Outlay, Military and Veterans  
19 Affairs, and Natural Resources, and was a member of the House  
20 committees on Appropriations; Families, Children, and Seniors;  
21 Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation; Elections and Ethics; and  
22 Military, Veterans, and Homeland Security. His dedication and  
23 integrity stand as a clear example of what it takes to be a  
24 successful public servant and strong leader; now, therefore, be it

26 expression of tribute to commend and thank the Honorable Steve  
27 Marino for his notable contributions to this legislative body and
