

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 410

The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution of tribute for the Honorable Daire Rendon.

2 Whereas, The House of Representatives now takes this
3 opportunity to commend the Honorable Daire Rendon for her service
4 to this chamber as the Representative for the One Hundred Third
5 District. Since assuming office in 2017, Representative Rendon has
6 carried out her admirable service in this chamber not only to her
7 constituents in Missaukee, Crawford, Kalkaska, Roscommon, and
8 Ogemaw counties, but to Michigan's citizens across the state; and

9 Whereas, Representative Rendon's professional and personal
10 experiences prior to beginning her service demonstrate expertise
11 she brought to bear during her tenure. Formerly an employee of the
12 Social Security Administration, Representative Rendon would go on

1 to purchase and successfully expand one business - Check Alert
2 Systems - and found another that remains in operation today -
3 Dragon Payment Systems. As evidence of the expertise she developed
4 as a business owner, Representative Rendon was appointed by
5 Governors John Engler and Jennifer Granholm, respectively, to serve
6 the Michigan Bureau of Consumer and Industry Services as a member
7 of the Michigan Collection Practices Advisory Board. Representative
8 Rendon also served as a chairperson of the Michigan Home Builders
9 Associate Council and as president of the Michigan Association of
10 Collection Agencies. In addition, Representative Rendon chaired the
11 first Missaukee County Relay for Life in 1998, reflecting a
12 lifelong support of the American Cancer Society and her drive to
13 aid research for the disease that she herself overcame. All of this
14 was accomplished with the help of Representative Rendon's devoted
15 family, including her husband, Bruce, two married daughters, and
16 three grandchildren; and

17 Whereas, Representative Rendon's legislative record reflects
18 the dedication and tenacity with which she served this chamber.
19 Representative Rendon served with distinction as the chair of both
20 the Insurance Committee and the Families, Children, and Seniors
21 Committee as well as the vice chair of the latter. Representative
22 Rendon also served as a member of the House committees on
23 Agriculture, Judiciary, Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation,
24 House Agriculture, Commerce and Trade, Michigan Competitiveness,
25 and Natural Resources. During her tenure, Representative Rendon
26 sponsored legislation to reform how electronic voting systems
27 operate to secure our elections, provide funding for supporting
28 tourism attractions in northern Michigan, to expand eligibility for
29 individuals to receive guardianship assistance payments, and

1 address a variety of other issues; now, therefore, be it
2 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we offer this
3 expression of tribute in gratitude to the Honorable Daire Rendon
4 for her dedicated service to this chamber and the State of
5 Michigan; and be it further

6 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
7 Representative Rendon as evidence of our sincere gratitude and best
8 wishes.
