The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution of tribute for the Honorable Terry J. Sabo.
- 2 Whereas, It is an honor to recognize the Honorable Terry J.
- 3 Sabo as he concludes his third term in the Michigan House of
- 4 Representatives. Representative Sabo has been a dedicated servant
- 5 to the citizens of Michigan, especially his constituents in the
- 6 Ninety-second District, which includes the cities of Muskegon,
- 7 Muskegon Heights, and North Muskegon and the townships of Muskegon,
- 8 Laketon, Fruitland, and Whitehall; and
- 9 Whereas, Representative Sabo has dedicated his life to
- 10 protecting and serving others. After graduating from Ravenna High
- 11 School, he served in the United States Air Force for four years as
- 12 a security policeman, then had a career as a certified firefighter

- 1 and police officer for over 25 years. In the latter part of his
- 2 professional career, he became involved in local government,
- 3 serving as a Muskegon County Road Commissioner and as chairman of
- 4 the Muskegon County Board of Commissioners. Representative Sabo
- 5 also strongly believes in civic service. He is a member of several
- 6 service organizations, including the Veterans of Foreign Wars
- 7 Auxiliary Post 8846, the American Legion Post 9, the Muskegon
- 8 Northside Lions Club, and the Muskegon Heights Optimist Club.
- 9 Representative Sabo and his wife, Denise, reside in their lifelong
- 10 home of Muskegon County, where they have four children and ten
- 11 grandchildren; and
- 12 Whereas, Since his election to the House in 2016,
- 13 Representative Sabo has been an active and influential legislator.
- 14 During his three terms, he served on numerous committees, providing
- 15 leadership as minority vice chair of the Committee on Military and
- 16 Veterans Affairs and the Committee on Workforce, Trades, and
- 17 Talent. He was also a member of the committees on Appropriations,
- 18 Agriculture, and Local Government and the Select Committee on
- 19 Reducing Car Insurance Rates. On the Appropriations Committee,
- 20 Representative Sabo was minority vice chair of the Subcommittee on
- 21 General Government and a member of the subcommittees on Agriculture
- 22 and Rural Development, Corrections, and Transportation.
- 23 Additionally, he is chair of the Michigan Legislative Labor Caucus.
- 24 Representative Sabo successfully sponsored legislation to codify
- 25 best practices in the foster care system, facilitate occupational
- 26 licensing, improve government finances, and fund several projects
- 27 in Muskegon County. Among those many projects were funding for the
- 28 Muskegon County EXIT Program, which helps incarcerated individuals
- 29 succeed upon returning to their community; various road and

- 1 infrastructure improvements; and the complete restoration of the
- 2 Muskegon South Breakwater Lighthouse; now, therefore, be it
- 3 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we offer this
- 4 expression of tribute to commend and thank the Honorable Terry J.
- 5 Sabo for his notable contributions to this legislative body and to
- 6 our state; and be it further
- 7 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 8 Representative Sabo as evidence of our gratitude and best wishes.
