

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.412

The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution of tribute for the Honorable Tim Sneller.

2 Whereas, It is with gratitude that we honor Representative Tim
3 Sneller as his time in the Michigan House of Representatives comes
4 to a close. He has served all of Michigan and the constituents in
5 the Fiftieth District with hard work and leadership; and

6 Whereas, Representative Sneller is a lifelong resident of
7 Genesee County and was raised by Andy and Margaret Sneller with
8 siblings Carol, Ronald, and Sandi. He attended Burton Bentley High
9 School and earned a bachelor's degree in political science and a
10 secondary teaching certificate from the University of Michigan-
11 Flint. Representative Sneller worked at the Flint General Motors
12 Truck and Bus Plant, where he became a proud member of the UAW

1 Local 598. He was also a social studies and history teacher. He is
2 a member of the Grand Blanc Chamber of Commerce, the Burton Chamber
3 of Congress, and the Greater Flint Health Coalition Board of
4 Directors and a sponsor of the Burton Project Heat is On.

5 Representative Sneller has a long history of legislative service,
6 as he worked for over thirty years as a legislative aide to several
7 legislators. His experience in these roles equipped him with the
8 skills necessary to be an effective legislator and dedicated public
9 servant; and

10 Whereas, Representative Sneller was elected to the House of
11 Representatives in 2016. During his time, he has exemplified
12 leadership as the minority vice chair of the Transportation
13 Committee. Representative Sneller also served with distinction as a
14 member of the House committees on Energy, Rules and
15 Competitiveness, Insurance, Agriculture, and Financial Liability
16 Reform. He has worked tirelessly on legislation to improve
17 transportation and vehicle safety measures across the state. He is
18 most proud of his dedication to his constituents in the Fiftieth
19 District. He hosted over three hundred coffee hours with
20 constituents and responded to over thirty thousand constituent
21 calls during the COVID-19 pandemic; now, therefore, be it
