## SENATE RESOLUTION NO.20

Senators McBroom, Zorn, Daley, Lauwers, Outman, Victory and VanderWall offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to encourage the Natural Resources Commission to
- 2 add Eastern sandhill cranes to the game species list and seek U.S.
- 3 Fish and Wildlife Service approval to establish an Eastern sandhill
- 4 crane hunting season.
- 5 Whereas, Michigan is home to an ever-increasing population of
- 6 Eastern sandhill cranes. The 2020 U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service
- 7 fall survey of Eastern sandhill cranes estimated 18,874 cranes in
- 8 Michigan prior to fall migration. An estimated 13,352 were recorded
- 9 in 2018; and
- 10 Whereas, The explosion in the Eastern sandhill crane
- 11 population in the state has caused significant issues for Michigan
- 12 farmers. Although depredation permits are available, the resource

- 1 is wasted as farmers are prohibited from possessing or consuming
- 2 dead birds taken under depredation permits. A hunting season would
- 3 reduce the number of nuisance birds while utilizing this food
- 4 resource; and
- 5 Whereas, Eastern sandhill cranes are already hunted in
- 6 Minnesota, Tennessee, and Kentucky when they migrate beyond
- 7 Michigan's borders. They are classified as a game species under the
- 8 federal Migratory Bird Treaty Act of 1916; and
- 9 Whereas, Hunting seasons are strictly regulated by the
- 10 Mississippi Flyway Council and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service
- 11 to ensure that the Eastern sandhill crane population remains
- 12 robust. Under the Eastern Population Crane Management Plan, states
- 13 may only receive approval for a hunting season from the U.S. Fish
- 14 and Wildlife Service after submitting pertinent information to the
- 15 Mississippi Flyway Council, including an estimate of the peak
- 16 number of Eastern sandhill cranes and time of migration over a
- 17 five-year period, proposed number of permits to be issued, and
- 18 proposed season dates. States with hunting seasons are required to
- 19 gather information from hunters and track the Eastern sandhill
- 20 crane population; now, therefore, be it
- 21 Resolved by the Senate, That we encourage the Natural
- 22 Resources Commission to add Eastern sandhill cranes to the game
- 23 species list and seek U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service approval to
- 24 establish an Eastern sandhill crane hunting season; and be it
- 25 further
- 26 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 27 members of the Michigan Natural Resources Commission, the Director
- 28 of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, and the Governor
- 29 of Michigan.
