

## SENATE RESOLUTION NO.144

Senators Hollier, Wojno, Barrett, Moss, Bayer, Huizenga, Chang and Schmidt offered the following resolution:

1       A resolution to condemn the racially-motivated violence that  
2 took place in Buffalo, New York and all racially-motivated  
3 violence.

4       Whereas, On Saturday, May 14, 2022 a shooter, likely motivated  
5 by racist ideology, murdered ten people and injured three people in  
6 a shooting that took place in a grocery store in Buffalo, New York.  
7 This shooting is just one of many violent acts that mark the rise  
8 of racially-motivated violence in our communities; and

9       Whereas, Racially-motivated violence is antithetical to our  
10 values as Michiganders and Americans. As leaders, it is our duty to  
11 call out bigotry and violence; now, therefore, be it

12       Resolved by the Senate, That we condemn the racially-motivated

1 violence that took place in Buffalo, New York; and be it further

2 Resolved, That we condemn all racially-motivated violence; and  
3 be it further

4 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the  
5 Governor of the State of Michigan.
