SENATE RESOLUTION NO.153

Senators Bumstead and Outman offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to designate June 2022 as Internet Safety Month. 2 Whereas, Internet Safety Month provides Michigan residents with an opportunity to learn more about the dangers of the Internet 3 and the importance of being safe and responsible online; and 4 Whereas, The Michigan Child Protection Registry was created by 6 the state Legislature in 2004 as a do-not-contact service for our families. This registry, administered by the Michigan Secretary of 7 8 State and enforced by the Attorney General's Office, is a free program that allows families to protect their households from 9 adult-oriented messages; and 10 Whereas, The Michigan Child Protection Registry honors 11 12 Internet Safety Month by reminding parents and guardians that, upon

- signing up for this registry, they can stop adult-oriented 1 advertisements including alcohol, tobacco, pornography, online 2 gambling, and illegal drugs from reaching their family's email 3 inboxes, cell phones, or instant messenger IDs; and 4 Whereas, We commend state and community organizations for 5 6 promoting awareness about the dangers of the Internet and for 7 providing information and training that develops the critical 8 thinking and decision-making skills needed to be safe online; and 9 Whereas, We call on Internet safety organizations, law
- enforcement, educators, community leaders, parents, and volunteers to increase their efforts to ensure online safety here in Michigan and the United States; now, therefore, be it
- Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative body designate June 2022 as Internet Safety Month; and be it further
- Resolved, That we urge all individuals to raise awareness and ensure their time on the Internet is safe and secure all year long.
