## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5385**

November 14, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Mentzer, Breen, Hope and Roth and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 348, entitled

"An act to regulate relationships between landlords and tenants relative to rental agreements for rental units; to regulate the payment, repayment, use and investment of security deposits; to provide for commencement and termination inventories of rental units; to provide for termination arrangements relative to rental units; to provide for legal remedies; and to provide penalties,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 554.601), as amended by 1995 PA 79.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Rental unit" means a structure or part of a structure
- 3 used as a home, residence, or sleeping unit by a single person or

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- household unit, or any grounds, or other facilities or area 1
- promised for the use of a residential tenant and includes, but 2
- without limitation, apartment units, boarding houses, rooming 3
- houses, mobile home spaces, and single and 2-family dwellings. 4
- 5 (b) "Rental agreement" means an agreement that establishes or
- 6 modifies the terms, conditions, rules, regulations, or any other
- 7 provisions concerning the use and occupancy of a rental unit.
- 8 (a) (c) "Landlord" means the any of the following:
- (i) The owner, lessor, or sublessor of the rental unit or the 10 property of which it is a part. and, in addition, means a
- 11 (ii) The person authorized to exercise any aspect of the
- 12 management of the premises, including a person who, that, directly
- 13 or indirectly, acts as a rental agent —or receives rent, other
- than as a bona fide purchaser, and who whether or not the person 14
- 15 has no an obligation to deliver the receipts rental payments to
- 16 another person.

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- 17 (d) "Tenant" means a person who occupies a rental unit for
- 18 residential purposes with the landlord's consent for an agreed upon
- 19 consideration.
- 20 (b) "Rental agreement" means an agreement that establishes or
- 21 modifies the terms, conditions, rules, regulations, or any other
- 22 provisions concerning the use and occupancy of a rental unit.
- 23 (c) "Rental unit" means a structure or part of a structure
- 24 used as a home, residence, or sleeping unit by a single person or
- 25 household unit, or any grounds or other facilities or area promised
- 26 for the use of a residential tenant. Rental unit includes, but is
- not limited to, an apartment unit, a boarding house, a rooming 27
- 28 house, a mobile home space, or a single- or 2-family dwelling.
- 29 Rental unit does not include a residence occupied by a seller on a

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## 1 temporary basis after the sale of that residence.

- 2 (d) (e) "Security deposit" means a deposit, in any amount,
- 3 paid by the tenant to the landlord or his or her the landlord's
- 4 agent to be held for the term of the rental agreement, or any part
- 5 of the term, and includes any required prepayment of rent other
- 6 than the first full rental period of the lease agreement; any sum
- 7 required to be paid as rent in any rental period in excess of the
- 8 average rent for the term; and any other amount of money or
- 9 property returnable to the tenant on condition of return of the
- 10 rental unit by the tenant in condition as required by the rental
- 11 agreement. Security deposit does not include either of the
- 12 following:
- 13 (i) An amount paid for an option to purchase, pursuant to under
- 14 a lease with option to purchase, unless it is shown the intent was
- 15 to evade this act.
- 16 (ii) An amount paid as a subscription for or purchase of a
- 17 membership in a cooperative housing association incorporated under
- 18 the laws of this state. As used in this subparagraph, "cooperative
- 19 housing association" means a consumer cooperative that provides
- 20 dwelling units to its members.
- 21 (e) (f) "Senior citizen housing" means housing for individuals
- 22 62 years of age or older that is subsidized in whole or in part
- 23 under any local, state, or federal program.
- 24 (f) "Tenant" means a person that occupies a rental unit for
- 25 residential purposes with the landlord's consent for an agreed-upon
- 26 consideration.
