

# SENATE BILL NO. 942

June 26, 2024, Introduced by Senators POLEHANKI, MCMORROW, KLINEFELT, CHANG, BAYER, IRWIN, GEISS, WOJNO, MOSS and SHINK and referred to the Committee on Civil Rights, Judiciary, and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
by amending section 224 (MCL 750.224), as amended by 2006 PA 401.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 224. (1) A person shall not manufacture, sell, offer for  
2 sale, or possess any of the following:

3           (a) A machine gun or firearm that shoots or is designed to  
4 shoot automatically more than 1 shot without manual reloading, by a  
5 single function of the trigger.

6           (b) A muffler or silencer.

1 (c) A bomb or bombshell.

2 (d) A blackjack, slungshot, billy, metallic knuckles, sand  
3 club, sand bag, or bludgeon.

4 (e) A device, weapon, cartridge, container, or contrivance  
5 designed to render a person temporarily or permanently disabled by  
6 the ejection, release, or emission of a gas or other substance.

7 **(f) A bump stock.**

8 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a  
9 felony, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years, or a  
10 fine of not more than \$2,500.00, or both.

11 (3) Subsection (1) does not apply to any of the following:

12 (a) A self-defense spray or foam device as defined in section  
13 224d.

14 (b) A person manufacturing firearms, explosives, or munitions  
15 of war by virtue of a contract with a department of the government  
16 of the United States.

17 (c) A person licensed by the ~~secretary~~ **Secretary** of the  
18 ~~treasury~~ **Treasury** of the United States or the ~~secretary's~~  
19 **Secretary's** delegate to manufacture, sell, or possess a machine  
20 gun, or a device, weapon, cartridge, container, or contrivance  
21 described in subsection (1).

22 (4) As used in this chapter: ~~"muffler"~~

23 **(a) "Muffler"** or "silencer" means 1 or more of the following:

24 **(i)** ~~(a)~~—A device for muffling, silencing, or deadening the  
25 report of a firearm.

26 **(ii)** ~~(b)~~—A combination of parts, designed or redesigned, and  
27 intended for use in assembling or fabricating a muffler or  
28 silencer.

29 **(iii)** ~~(c)~~—A part, designed or redesigned, and intended only for

1 use in assembling or fabricating a muffler or silencer.

2 (b) "Bump stock" means a device that allows a semiautomatic  
3 firearm to shoot more than 1 shot with a single pull of the trigger  
4 by harnessing the recoil energy of the semiautomatic firearm to  
5 which the device is affixed so that the trigger resets and  
6 continues firing without additional physical manipulation of the  
7 trigger by the shooter.
