A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 36202 (MCL 324.36202), as amended by 2016 PA 265.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 36202. (1) The agricultural preservation fund is created
 within the state treasury.
- 3 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from
- 4 any source for deposit into the fund, including federal funds,
- 5 other state revenues, gifts, bequests, and other donations. The
- 6 state treasurer shall direct the investment of the fund and shall
- 7 credit to the fund interest and earnings from fund investments.
- 8 (3) Money in the fund at the close of the fiscal year shall

- 4 (5) Money in the fund may be expended, upon appropriation, as follows:
- 6 (a) Not Subject to subsection (6), not more than \$1,400,000.00
 7 \$2,100,000.00 annually may be expended for the administrative costs
 8 of the department and the board in implementing this part and part

- 10 (b) After expenditures for the administrative costs under 11 subdivision (a), money in the fund may be used, expended, upon 12 approval of the board, to provide grants to local units of 13 government pursuant to section 36203.
- (c) After If, after expenditures under subdivisions (a) and
 (b), have been made, if the amount of money remaining in the fund
 exceeds \$5,000,000.00, money in the fund may be used, expended,
 upon approval of the board, pursuant to part 361 for the purchase
 of development rights to farmland or the acquisition of
 agricultural conservation easements.
 - (6) For the 2025-2026 state fiscal year and each state fiscal year thereafter, the state treasurer shall adjust the amount in subsection (5)(a) by the percentage by which the Consumer Price Index for the preceding calendar year exceeds or is less than the Consumer Price Index for 2023. If an amount produced by a computation under this subsection is not a multiple of \$1,000.00, the state treasurer shall round the amount to the nearest multiple of \$1,000.00. The department of treasury shall post the adjusted amount for each state fiscal year on its website by the preceding June 1. As used in this subsection, "Consumer Price Index" means
