- 4 individual being prohibited from possessing a firearm, the
- 5 prosecuting attorney shall not amend the charge in a manner that
- 6 would allow the individual to legally possess a firearm if a

- 1 conviction for the amended charge would not prohibit the individual
- 2 from possessing a firearm.
- 3 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 4 after the date it is enacted into law.
