THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 224q. (1) A person shall not possess, use, transport,
- 2 purchase, carry, ship, receive, or distribute a firearm or
- 3 ammunition in this state if that person is prohibited under 18 USC
- 4 922(g)(9) from shipping or transporting in interstate or foreign
- 5 commerce, or possessing in or affecting commerce, any firearm or
- 6 ammunition, or receiving any firearm or ammunition which has been

- 1 shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce.
- 2 (2) A person who possesses, uses, transports, purchases,
- 3 carries, ships, receives, or distributes a firearm or ammunition in
- 4 this state in violation of this section is guilty of a felony
- 5 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or a fine of
- 6 not more than \$5,000.00, or both.
- 7 (3) Any single criminal transaction where a person possesses,
- 8 uses, transports, sells, carries, ships, or distributes ammunition
- 9 in violation of this section, regardless of the amount of
- 10 ammunition involved, constitutes 1 offense.
- 11 (4) As used in this section, "ammunition" means any projectile
- 12 that, in its current state, may be expelled from a firearm by an
- 13 explosive.
