## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5227**

October 25, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Neeley, Scott, Liberati, O'Neal and Brenda Carter and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 303 (MCL 750.303), as amended by 1996 PA 129.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 303. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 2 chapter, a person who for hire, gain, or reward, keeps or maintains
- 3 a gaming room, gaming table, game of skill or chance, or game
- 4 partly of skill and partly of chance, used for gaming, or who
- 5 permits a gaming room, or gaming table, or game to be kept,
- 6 maintained, or played on premises occupied or controlled by the
- 7 person, is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for

- 1 not more than 2 years, or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00. A
- 2 person who aids, assists, or abets in the keeping or maintaining of
- 3 a gaming room, gaming table, or game, is guilty of a misdemeanor,
- 4 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2 years, or a fine of
- 5 not more than \$1,000.00.
- 6 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a mechanical amusement
- 7 device which that may, through the application of an element of
- 8 skill, reward the player with the right to replay the mechanical
- 9 amusement device at no additional cost if the mechanical amusement
- 10 device is not allowed to does all of the following:
  - (a) Does not accumulate more than 15 replays at 1 time. ; the

- (b) Is designed so that accumulated free replays may only be
- 14 discharged by reactivating the device for 1 additional play for
- 15 each accumulated free replay. ; and the mechanical amusement device

- 17 (c) Makes no permanent record, directly or indirectly, of the
- 18 free replays awarded.
- 19 (3) Subsection (1) does not apply to a slot machine if the
- 20 slot machine is 25 years old or older and is not used for gambling
- 21 purposes. As used in this section, "slot machine" means a
- 22 mechanical device, an essential part of which is a drum or reel
- 23 which bears an insignia and which when operated may deliver, as a
- 24 result of the application of an element of chance, a token or money
- 25 or property, or by operation of which a person may become entitled
- 26 to receive, as a result of the application of an element of chance,
- 27 a token or money or property.
- 28 (4) A slot machine which is being used for a gambling purpose
- 29 in violation of subsection (3) shall must be confiscated and turned

- 1 over to the director of the department of state police for auction.
- 2 (5) Subsection (1) does not apply to a crane game. As used in
- 3 this section, "crane game" means an amusement machine activated by
- 4 the insertion of a coin by which the player uses 1 or more buttons,
- 5 joysticks, or similar means of control, or a combination of those
- 6 means of control, to position a mechanical or electromechanical
- 7 claw, or other retrieval device, over a prize, toy, novelty, or an
- 8 edible item having a wholesale value of not more than \$3.75, and
- 9 thereby attempts to retrieve the prize, toy, novelty, or edible
- 10 item. Every prize, toy, or edible item must be retrievable by the
- 11 claw. A slot machine is not considered a crane game.
- 12 (6) A person who knowingly alters a crane game that is
- 13 available for play so that the crane game is not in compliance with
- 14 the elements of the definition <del>contained</del> in subsection (5) is
- 15 guilty of a felony, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2
- years  $\tau$  or a fine of not more than \$20,000.00, or both.
- 17 (7) A law enforcement officer may confiscate any crane game
- 18 that is available for play and is not in compliance with the
- 19 elements of the definition contained in subsection (5). The
- 20 confiscated crane games and their contents shall must not be
- 21 destroyed, altered, dismantled, sold, or otherwise disposed of
- 22 except upon order of a court having competent jurisdiction.
- 23 (8) The following notice shall must be conspicuously posted on
- 24 the front of every crane game located in this state: "This game is
- 25 not licensed or regulated by the state of Michigan.".
- 26 (9) As used in this chapter, "slot machine" means any
- 27 mechanical, electrical, electromechanical, or other device,
- 28 contrivance, or machine that, on insertion of a coin, token, or
- 29 similar object, or on payment of any consideration, is available to

- 1 play or operate. The play or operation of the slot machine, whether
- 2 by reason of skill of the operator or application of the element of
- 3 chance, or both, may deliver to or entitle the person playing or
- 4 operating the machine to receive cash, premiums, merchandise,
- 5 tokens, or anything of value, whether the payoff is made
- 6 automatically from the machine or in any other manner.
