A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

(MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 5543; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 5543. (1) As used in this section, "covered material"
 means concrete, steel, glass, wood, or polyvinyl chloride.
- 3 (2) By December 1, 2024, the department shall submit to the 4 governor and legislature a report on all of the following:
- 5 (a) The use of environmental product declarations to measure

- 1 the climate impact of covered materials procured by this state.
- 2 (b) The use of performance incentives to encourage adoption of
- 3 low-carbon covered materials and methods by manufacturers that
- 4 provide covered materials for state-funded projects.
- 5 (c) The establishment of expedited product evaluation,
- 6 testing, and approval protocols for low-carbon covered materials.
- 7 (d) The use of methods of compliance, including, but not
- 8 limited to, maximum covered material content specifications and
- 9 specifications based on maximum potential for global warming.
- 10 (3) In preparing the report, the department shall do both of
- 11 the following:
- 12 (a) Consider environmental and health and safety impacts.
- 13 (b) Consult with any relevant associations that set industry
- 14 standards for the procurement of low-carbon covered materials and
- 15 with affected contractors and subcontractors.
- 16 (4) This section is repealed effective May 1, 2025.
