

SENATE BILL NO. 373

June 06, 2023, Introduced by Senators CHANG, MOSS, SINGH, BRINKS, WOJNO, CAVANAGH, HERTEL, GEISS, POLEHANKI, IRWIN, MCCANN, CAMILLERI, CHERRY, SHINK, MCDONALD RIVET, MCMORROW and MCBROOM and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending section 2 (MCL 168.2), as amended by 2018 PA 603.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Absent voter" is a voter who utilizes the process
- 3 described in section 759.
- 4 (b) "Absent voter ballot" means a ballot that is issued to a
- 5 voter through the ~~absentee~~**absent** voter process.

1 (c) "Ballot container" is defined in section 14a.

2 (d) "Business day" or "secular day" means a day that is not a
3 Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.

4 (e) "Clearly observable boundaries" is defined in section
5 654a.

6 (f) "Common carrier" means a company that transports mail, on
7 reasonable request, on regular routes and at set rates.

8 (g) **"Educational institution" means a public or private**
9 **institution, or a separate school or department of a public or**
10 **private institution, that is authorized by law or an accrediting**
11 **body to grant or issue a diploma, degree, certificate, or license,**
12 **or to grant approval to practice a profession or engage in an**
13 **enterprise, and includes, but is not limited to, an academy, high**
14 **school, college, university, community college, junior college,**
15 **secondary school, extension course, or a business, nursing,**
16 **professional, secretarial, technical, or vocational school.**

17 (h) ~~(g)~~—"Election" means an election or primary election at
18 which the electors of this state or of a subdivision of this state
19 choose or nominate by ballot an individual for public office or
20 decide a ballot question lawfully submitted to them.

21 (i) ~~(h)~~—"Election precinct" is defined in section 654.

22 (j) ~~(i)~~—"Fall" state and county conventions and "spring" state
23 and county conventions are assigned meanings in section 596.

24 (k) ~~(j)~~—"General election" or "general November election"
25 means the election held on the November regular election date in an
26 even numbered year.

27 (l) ~~(k)~~—"Identification for election purposes" means, if issued
28 to the individual presenting the card or document and if presented
29 for voting purposes the name on the card or document sufficiently

1 matches the individual's name in ~~his or her~~ **the individual's** voter
2 registration record so as to accurately identify the individual as
3 the registered elector, or if issued to the individual presenting
4 the card or document and if presented for voter registration
5 purposes, any of the following:

6 (i) An operator's or chauffeur's license issued under the
7 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, or an
8 enhanced driver license issued under the enhanced driver license
9 and enhanced official state personal identification card act, 2008
10 PA 23, MCL 28.301 to 28.308.

11 (ii) An official state personal identification card issued
12 under 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 to 28.300, or an enhanced official
13 state personal identification card issued under the enhanced driver
14 license and enhanced official state personal identification card
15 act, 2008 PA 23, MCL 28.301 to 28.308.

16 (iii) A current operator's or chauffeur's license issued by
17 another state.

18 (iv) A current state personal identification card issued by
19 another state.

20 (v) A current state government ~~issued~~ photo identification
21 card **issued by this state.**

22 (vi) A current United States passport or ~~federal government~~
23 ~~issued~~ **current** photo identification card **issued by the federal**
24 **government.**

25 (vii) A current military photo identification card **issued by**
26 **this state or the federal government.**

27 (viii) A current tribal photo identification card **issued by a**
28 **tribal government.**

29 (ix) **A current photo identification card issued by a local**

2 **(x)** ~~(ix)~~—A current student photo identification card issued by
3 ~~a high school~~ **an educational institution** in this state. ~~, an~~
4 ~~institution of higher education in this state described in section~~
5 ~~4, 5, or 6 of article VIII of the state constitution of 1963, a~~
6 ~~junior college or community college established under section 7 of~~
7 ~~article VIII of the state constitution of 1963, or another~~
8 ~~accredited degree or certificate granting college or university,~~
9 ~~junior college, or community college located in this state.~~

10 **(m)** ~~(l)~~—"Immediate family" means an individual's father,
11 mother, son, daughter, brother, sister, and spouse and a relative
12 of any degree residing in the same household as that individual.
