THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 416. Upon commencement of mental health treatment, the

- 5 treatment, must be communicated orally communicated and in writing

- 5 include the process through which the patient can end voluntary

- 7 (b) Both of the following must be given to the patient, and
- 8 the individual who executed the written consent, and to 1 other
- 9 individual designated by the patient:
- 10 (i) A copy of the written consent.
- 11 (ii) Notwithstanding any other provision under this act, a copy
- 12 of the form described under section 1419. A copy of the form
- 13 described in this subparagraph must be given as described in this
- 14 subdivision even if an intention to terminate mental health
- 15 treatment is not told to a hospital or provider of mental health
- 16 treatment.
