SUMMARY:

House Bill 4895 would amend the Occupational Code to require the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) to allow 100% of the continuing education requirements established for an occupation regulated under the act to be completed online or via electronic media, so long as the online or electronic version of the continuing education program meets the applicable standards set by administrative rule.

MCL 339.314

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 4895 would have a minimal fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. The bill would require LARA to allow 100% of continuing education requirements for occupations under the Occupational Code to be completed online. The department may incur costs associated with the rules promulgation process, but any costs would likely be minimal.
