## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5144**

October 28, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Byrnes, Glanville, Neyer, Schmaltz, Wooden, Arbit, Breen, Conlin, Herzberg, T. Carter, O'Neal and Rheingans and referred to Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 230, entitled "Stille-DeRossett-Hale single state construction code act," by amending section 10 (MCL 125.1510), as amended by 2016 PA 409.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 10. (1) Except as otherwise provided in the code, before
- 2 construction of a building or structure, the owner, or the owner's
- 3 builder, architect, engineer, interior designer that prepares
- 4 interior technical submissions in the practice of interior design,
- 5 or agent, shall submit an application in writing to the appropriate

- 1 enforcing agency for a building permit. The application shall must
- 2 be on a form prescribed by the commission and shall must be
- 3 accompanied by payment of the fee established by the enforcing
- 4 agency. The application shall must contain a detailed statement in
- 5 writing, verified by affidavit of the individual making it, of the
- 6 specifications for the building or structure, and full and complete
- 7 copies of the plans drawn to scale of the proposed work. A site
- 8 plan showing the dimensions, and the location of the proposed
- 9 building or structure and other buildings or structures on the same
- 10 premises, shall must be submitted with the application. The
- 11 application shall must state in full the name and residence, by
- 12 street and number, of the owner in fee of the land on which the
- 13 building or structure will be constructed, and the purposes for
- 14 which it will be used.
- 15 (2) If construction is proposed to be undertaken by a person
- 16 other than the owner of the land in fee, the statement shall must
- 17 contain the full name and residence, by street and number, of the
- 18 owner and also of the person proposing the construction. The
- 19 affidavit shall must state that the specifications and plans are
- 20 true and complete and contain a correct description of the building
- 21 or structure, lot or parcel, and proposed work. The statements and
- 22 affidavits may be made by an owner, or the owner's attorney, agent,
- 23 engineer, architect, interior designer that prepares interior
- 24 technical submissions in the practice of interior design, or
- 25 builder, by the person who—that proposes to make the construction
- 26 or alteration, or by that person's agent, engineer, architect, or
- 27 builder. A person shall is not be recognized as the agent,
- 28 attorney, engineer, architect, interior designer that prepares
- 29 interior technical submissions in the practice of interior design,

- 1 or builder of another person unless the person seeking recognition
- 2 files with the enforcing agency a written instrument , which shall
- 3 be that is an architectural, engineering, or construction contract,
- 4 power of attorney, or letter of authorization signed by that other
- 5 person designating that designates the person seeking recognition
- 6 as the agent, attorney, architect, engineer, interior designer that
- 7 prepares interior technical submissions in the practice of interior
- 8 design, or builder and, in case of a residential builder or
- 9 maintenance and alteration contractor, architect, or engineer,
- 10 setting forth providing the license number of the person seeking
- 11 recognition and the expiration date of the license.
- 12 (3) A person licensed or required to be licensed as a
- 13 residential builder or residential maintenance and alteration
- 14 contractor under article 24 of the occupational code, 1980 PA 299,
- 15 MCL <del>339.101 to 339.2919, </del>339.2401 to 339.2412, a plumbing
- 16 contractor or master or journeyman journey plumber under article 11
- 17 of the skilled trades regulation act, 2016 PA 407, MCL 339.6101 to
- 18 339.6133, an electrical contractor, master electrician, or
- 19 electrical journeyman under article 7 of the skilled trades
- 20 regulation act, 2016 PA 407, MCL 339.5701 to 339.5739, or pursuant
- 21 to—a local ordinance, an interior designer that prepares interior
- 22 technical submissions in the practice of interior design under
- 23 article 20A of the occupational code, 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.2015 to
- 24 339.2025, or a mechanical contractor under article 8 of the skilled
- 25 trades regulation act, 2016 PA 407, MCL 339.5801 to 339.5819, who
- 26 applies for a building permit to perform work on a residential
- 27 building or a residential structure shall, in addition to any other
- 28 information required pursuant to under this act, provide on the
- 29 building permit application all of the following information:

- (a) The occupational license number of the applicant and the
  expiration date of the occupational license.
- 3 (b) One of the following:

- 17 (c) One of the following:
- 18 (i) The—If the applicant is required to have an employer
- 19 identification number under section 6109 of the internal revenue
- 20 code of 1986, 26 USC 6109, the employer identification number. , if
- 21 the applicant is required to have an employer identification number
- 22 pursuant to section 6109 of the internal revenue code, 26 USC 6109.
- 23 (ii) The—If the applicant is not required to have an employer
- 24 identification number under section 6109 of the internal revenue
- 25 code of 1986, 26 USC 6109, the reasons for exemption from the
- 26 requirement to have an employer identification number pursuant to
- 27 under section 6109 of the internal revenue code of 1986, 26 USC
- 28 6109. , if the applicant is not required to have an employer
- 29 identification number pursuant to that section.

- 1 (d) One of the following:
- 2 (i) The—If the applicant is required to make contributions
- 3 under the Michigan employment security act, 1936 (Ex Sess) PA 1,
- 4 MCL 421.1 to 421.75, the Michigan employment security commission
- 5 employer number. , if the applicant is required to make
- 6 contributions pursuant to the Michigan employment security act,
- 7 1936 (Ex Sess) PA 1, MCL 421.1 to 421.75.
- 8 (ii) If the applicant is not required to make contributions
- 9 under the Michigan employment security act, 1936 (Ex Sess) PA 1,

- 13 (4) The building permit application form shall must contain
- 14 the following statement in 8-point boldfaced type immediately above
- 15 the location for the applicant's signature:
- "Section 23a of the Stille-DeRossett-Hale single state
- 17 construction code act, of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523a,
- 18 prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing
- 19 requirements of this state relating to for persons who that are to
- 20 perform work on a residential building or a residential structure.
- 21 Violators of section 23a are subjected subject to civil fines."
- 22 (5) The application for a building permit shall must be filed
- 23 with the enforcing agency and the application and any other writing
- 24 prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or retained by the
- 25 enforcing agency in the performance of an official function shall
- 26 must be made available to the public in compliance with the freedom
- 27 of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to 15.246. An
- 28 application shall must not be removed from the custody of the
- 29 enforcing agency after a building permit has been issued.

- 1 (6) This section shall must be construed to allow the
- 2 imposition of requirements in the code, or in other laws or
- 3 ordinances, for additional permits for particular kinds of work,
- 4 including plumbing and electrical, or in other specified
- 5 situations. The requirements of the code may provide for issuance
- 6 of a construction permits permit for a certain of the systems
- 7 system of a structure and allow construction to commence on those
- 8 systems that system if approved under that the permit even though
- 9 the design and approval of all the systems of the structure have
- 10 not been completed and subsequent construction permits have not
- 11 been issued.
- 12 (7) A building permit is not required for ordinary repairs of
- 13 a building or structure.
- 14 (8) A building permit is not required for a building
- 15 incidental to the use for agricultural purposes of the land on
- 16 which the building is located if the building is not used in the
- 17 business of retail trade.
- 18 (9) A qualifying roadside stand is exempt from the plumbing
- 19 fixture requirements of this act and the code and is not required
- 20 to have electric power. However, a A qualifying roadside stand that
- 21 has electric power must comply with the electrical code. This
- 22 subsection does not exempt a qualifying roadside stand from a
- 23 requirement to obtain a building permit. As used in this
- 24 subsection, "qualifying roadside stand" means a roadside stand that
- 25 meets all of the following requirements:
- 26 (a) Is used only for seasonal retail trade in agricultural
- 27 products.
- 28 (b) At least 50% of the agricultural products offered for sale
- 29 at the roadside stand are produced on a farm that is owned or

- 1 controlled by the person who that owns the roadside stand.
- 2 (c) Is not larger than 400 square feet.
- 3 (d) Is securely anchored to the ground.
- 4 (10) A tent that meets the requirements of subsection (9)(a),
- 5 (b), and (c) is exempt from this act and the code.
- 6 (11) As used in this section:
- 7 (a) "Interior designer" means that term as defined in section
- 8 2015 of the occupational code, 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.2015.
- 9 (b) "Interior technical submission" means that term as defined
- 10 in section 2015 of the occupational code, 1980 PA 299, MCL
- 11 339.2015.
- 12 (c) "Practice of interior design" means that term as defined
- 13 in section 2015 of the occupational code, 1980 PA 299, MCL
- 14 339.2015.
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 16 unless House Bill No. 5142 (request no. H01671'25) of the 103rd
- 17 Legislature is enacted into law.
