HOUSE BILL NO. 5157

October 29, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Kuhn, Tisdel and Steele and referred to Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 89a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 89a. (1) A person who delivers a schedule 1 or 2
- 2 controlled substance, other than marihuana, to another individual
- 3 in violation of section 7401 of the public health code, 1978 PA
- 4 368, MCL 333.7401, that is consumed by that individual or any other
- 5 individual and that causes serious injury to that individual or

- other individual is quilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment 1
- 2 for life or any term of years.
- 3 (2) As used in this section:
- (a) "Serious impairment of a body function" includes, but is 4
- not limited to, 1 or more of the following: 5
- 6 (i) Loss of a limb or loss of use of a limb.
- (ii) Loss of a foot, hand, finger, or thumb or loss of use of a 7
- 8 foot, hand, finger, or thumb.
- 9 (iii) Loss of an eye or ear or loss of use of an eye or ear.
- 10 (iv) Loss or substantial impairment of a bodily function.
- 11 (v) Serious visible disfigurement.
- 12 (vi) A comatose state that lasts for more than 3 days.
- (vii) Measurable brain or mental impairment. 13
- 14 (viii) A skull fracture or other serious bone fracture.
- (ix) Subdural hemorrhage or subdural hematoma. 15
- 16 (x) Loss of an organ.
- 17 (b) "Serious injury" means permanent, serious disfigurement,
- 18 serious impairment of health, or serious impairment of a body
- 19 function of an individual.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 21 after the date it is enacted into law.
