A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 7204 (MCL 333.7204), as amended by 2012 PA 182.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7204. If a substance is designated, rescheduled, or
- 2 deleted as a controlled substance under federal law and notice of
- 3 that designation, rescheduling, or deletion is given to the
- 4 administrator, the substance shall must be similarly scheduled
- 5 under section 7201 unless the administrator holds a board meeting

- 1 within the expiration of 91 not more than 30 days after notice is
- 2 received to determine whether the substance should be similarly
- 3 controlled under section 7201. If the administrator decides not to
- 4 similarly control schedule the substance, the administrator shall,
- 5 within 91 not more than 30 days after that decision is made,
- 6 publish the reasons for that determination.
