## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5307**

December 02, 2025, Introduced by Reps. VanderWall, Rogers, Borton, Prestin, Kunse, Outman, Bohnak, Markkanen, Fairbairn, Fox and Green and referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 40118 (MCL 324.40118), as amended by 2023 PA 55.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 40118. (1) An individual who violates this part, an order or interim order issued under this part, or a condition of a permit
- 3 issued under this part, except for a violation specified in
- 4 subsections (2) to (19), is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by

- 1 imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not less than
- 2 \$50.00 or more than \$500.00, or both, and the costs of prosecution.
- 3 In addition, a permit issued by the department under this part must
- 4 be revoked pursuant to in accordance with the administrative
- 5 procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328.
- 6 (2) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an
- 7 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the
- 8 possession or taking of any game, except deer, bear, wild turkey,
- 9 wolf, waterfowl, moose, or elk, is quilty of a misdemeanor
- 10 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of
- 11 not less than \$100.00 or more than \$1,000.00, or both, and the
- 12 costs of prosecution.
- 13 (3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection or
- 14 subsection (19), an individual who violates a provision of this
- 15 part or an order or interim order issued under this part regarding
- 16 the possession or taking of deer, bear, wild turkey, or wolf is
- 17 quilty of a misdemeanor. and The court may be imprisoned sentence
- 18 the individual to imprisonment for not more than 90 days, shall be
- 19 fined impose a fine of not less than \$200.00 or more than
- 20 \$1,000.00, and shall be ordered order the individual to pay the
- 21 costs of prosecution. An individual shall not be punished under
- 22 this subsection for lawfully removing, capturing, or destroying a
- 23 wolf under 2008 PA 290, MCL 324.95151 to 324.95155, or 2008 PA 318,
- **24** MCL 324.95161 to 324.95167.
- 25 (4) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an
- 26 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the
- 27 possession or taking of elk is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable
- 28 by imprisonment for not more than 180 days or a fine of not less
- 29 than \$500.00 or more than \$2,000.00, or both, and the costs of

- 1 prosecution.
- 2 (5) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an
- 3 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the
- 4 possession or taking of moose is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable
- 5 by imprisonment for not more than 1 year and a fine of not less
- 6 than \$1,000.00 or more than \$5,000.00, and the costs of
- 7 prosecution.
- **8** (6) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an
- 9 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the
- 10 possession or taking of waterfowl is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 11 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of
- 12 not less than \$250.00 or more than \$500.00, or both, and the costs
- 13 of prosecution. An individual who violates a provision of this part
- 14 or an order or interim order issued under this part regarding the
- 15 possession or taking of waterfowl a second or subsequent time is
- 16 quilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more
- 17 than 90 days or a fine of \$500.00, or both, and the costs of
- 18 prosecution.
- 19 (7) An individual sentenced under subsection (3), (14), or
- 20 (15) shall not secure or possess a license of any kind to hunt
- 21 during the remainder of the year in which convicted and the next 3
- 22 succeeding calendar years. An individual sentenced under subsection
- 23 (11) shall not secure or possess a license of any kind to hunt
- 24 during the remainder of the year in which convicted and the next
- 25 succeeding calendar year, or longer in the discretion of the court.
- 26 (8) In addition to the penalties provided for violating this
- 27 part or an order issued under this part, an individual convicted of
- 28 the illegal killing, possessing, purchasing, or selling of a bear
- 29 or an antlered white-tailed deer is subject to the following

- 1 penalties:
- 2 (a) For a first offense, the individual shall not secure or
- 3 possess a license of any kind to hunt for an additional 2 calendar
- 4 years after the penalties imposed under subsection (7).
- 5 (b) For a second or subsequent offense, the individual shall
- 6 not secure or possess a license of any kind to hunt for an
- 7 additional 7 calendar years after the penalties imposed under
- 8 subsection (7).
- **9** (9) In addition to the penalties provided for violating this
- 10 part or an order issued under this part, an individual convicted of
- 11 the illegal killing, possessing, purchasing, or selling of a wild
- 12 turkey shall not secure or possess a license of any kind to hunt
- 13 for an additional 2 calendar years after the penalties imposed
- 14 under subsection (7).
- 15 (10) An individual sentenced under subsection (4) or (5) is
- 16 subject to the following penalties:
- 17 (a) For a first offense, the individual shall not secure or
- 18 possess a license of any kind to hunt for the remainder of the year
- 19 in which convicted and the next 15 succeeding calendar years.
- 20 (b) For a second offense, the individual shall not secure or
- 21 possess a license of any kind to hunt for the remainder of that
- 22 individual's life.
- 23 (11) An individual who violates section 40113(1) is guilty of
- 24 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days
- 25 or a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$500.00, or both,
- 26 and the costs of prosecution.
- 27 (12) An individual who violates section 40113(2) is guilty of
- 28 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days
- or a fine of not less than \$50.00 or more than \$500.00, or both,

- 1 and the costs of prosecution.
- (13) An individual who violates section 40113(3) is guilty of
  a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days
  or a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$500.00, or both,
  and the costs of prosecution.
- 6 (14) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an 7 order or interim order issued under this part regarding the taking 8 or possession of an animal that has been designated by the 9 department to be a protected animal, other than an animal that 10 appears on a list prepared under section 36505, is guilty of a 11 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$1,000.00, or both, 12 13 and the costs of prosecution.
- 14 (15) An individual who buys or sells game or a protected
  15 animal in violation of this part or an order or interim order
  16 issued under this part is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
  17 imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not more than
  18 \$1,000.00, or both, for the first offense, and is guilty of a
  19 felony for each subsequent offense.
- 20 (16) An individual who willfully violates a provision of this part or an order or interim order issued under this part by using 21 an illegally constructed snare or cable restraint is guilty of a 22 23 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or 24 a fine of \$1,000.00 for the first illegally constructed snare or 25 cable restraint and \$250.00 for each subsequent illegally 26 constructed snare or cable restraint, or both, and the costs of 27 prosecution.
- (17) An individual who violates a provision of this part or anorder or interim order issued under this part regarding the

- 1 importation of a cervid carcass or parts of a cervid carcass, other
- 2 than hides, deboned meat, quarters or other parts of a cervid that
- 3 do not have any part of the spinal column or head attached,
- 4 finished taxidermy products, cleaned teeth, antlers, or antlers
- 5 attached to a skullcap cleaned of brain and muscle tissue, from
- 6 another state or province is quilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
- 7 imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not less than
- **8** \$500.00 or more than \$2,000.00, or both, and the costs of
- 9 prosecution.
- 10 (18) If an individual is convicted of a violation of this part
- 11 or an order or interim order issued under this part and it is
- 12 alleged in the complaint and proved or admitted at trial or
- 13 ascertained by the court after conviction that the individual had
- 14 been previously convicted 2 times within the preceding 5 years for
- 15 a violation of this part or an order or interim order issued under
- 16 this part, the individual is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
- 17 imprisonment for not more than 180 days or a fine of not less than
- 18 \$500.00 or more than \$2,000.00, or both, and the costs of
- 19 prosecution.
- 20 (19) An individual who violates a provision of this part or an
- 21 order or interim order issued under this part regarding any of the
- 22 following is responsible for a state civil infraction and may be
- 23 ordered to pay a civil fine of not more than \$150.00:
- 24 (a) Attaching that individual's name, driver license number,
- 25 or sportcard number to a ground blind.
- 26 (b) Attaching that individual's name, driver license number,
- 27 or sportcard number to a tree stand, scaffold, or raised platform.
- 28 (c) Supplemental feeding of deer.
- 29 (d) Reporting of a deer harvest or retention of a deer harvest
