A bill to amend 2016 PA 436, entitled "Unmanned aircraft systems act,"

(MCL 259.301 to 259.331) by adding section 8.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 8. (1) A police officer may intercept, disable, or destroy an unmanned aircraft that is flying in a manner that poses a risk to public safety or that is flying in violation of federal law or Federal Aviation Administration guidelines.
- 5 (2) A police officer who intercepts, disables, or destroys an

- unmanned aircraft under subsection (1) is not liable to the owner

 the unmanned aircraft for damage to the unmanned aircraft.
- 3 (3) This section does not apply unless federal law is amended
- 4 to allow a police officer to intercept, disable, or destroy an
- 5 unmanned aircraft as described in subsection (1).
