March 18, 2025, Introduced by Senator ANTHONY and referred to Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled
"The state school aid act of 1979,"
by amending sections 11, 17b, 201, 206, 236, and 241 (MCL 388.1611,
388.1617b, 388.1801, 388.1806, 388.1836, and 388.1841), section 11
as amended by 2024 PA 148, section 17b as amended by 2007 PA 137,
and sections 201, 206, 236, and 241 as amended by 2024 PA 120.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

 6 2000 PA 489, MCL 12.262, an amount not to exceed ~~\$125,000,000.00~~
 7 **\$100.00** from the school transportation fund created under section
 8 22k, an amount not to exceed ~~\$71,000,000.00~~ **\$100.00** from the
 9 enrollment stabilization fund created under section 29, an amount
 10 not to exceed ~~\$30,000,000.00~~ **\$100.00** from the school meals reserve
 11 fund created under section 30e, an amount not to exceed

28 Sec. 17b. (1) Not later than October 20, November 20, December
 29 20, January 20, February 20, March 20, April 20, May 20, June 20,

1 July 20, and August 20, the department shall prepare electronic
2 files of the amount to be distributed under this act in the
3 installment to the districts and intermediate districts and deliver
4 the electronic files to the state treasurer, and the state
5 treasurer shall pay the installments on each of those dates or, if
6 the date is not a business day, on the next business day following
7 that date. Except as otherwise provided in this act, the portion of
8 the district's or intermediate district's state fiscal year
