- 1 A resolution to declare April 19, 2025, as Patriots' Day in
- 2 the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, April 19, 2025, marks the 250th anniversary of the
- 4 day in 1775 when the towns of Lexington and Concord were marched
- 5 upon by British regulars in an effort to confiscate local militias'
- 6 munitions; and
- 7 Whereas, The result was the "shot heard around the world" and
- 8 the rout of the British troops; and
- 9 Whereas, The states of Connecticut, Florida, Massachusetts,
- 10 Maine, North Dakota, and Wisconsin observe April 19th as Patriots'
- 11 Day each year; and

- 1 Whereas, Unlike the celebrations of July 4th, Patriots' Day
- 2 serves to remind citizens of the War for Independence and the
- 3 sacrifices endured during that eight-year struggle. It commemorates
- 4 the struggle through which the nation passed in its early days;
- 5 now, therefore, be it
- 6 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 7 this legislative body declare April 19, 2025, as Patriots' Day in
- 8 the state of Michigan; and be it further
- 9 Resolved, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 10 Michigan Society, Sons of the American Revolution.
