- 12 Whereas, Michigan is home to five remarkable National Park

- 1 Service sites, including Isle Royale National Park, Sleeping Bear
- 2 Dunes National Lakeshore, Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore,
- 3 Keweenaw National Historical Park, and River Raisin National
- 4 Battlefield Park; and
- 5 Whereas, These National Park Service sites provide
- 6 unparalleled opportunities for outdoor recreation, education, and
- 7 the protection of unique ecosystems, historical landmarks, and
- 8 native wildlife; and
- 9 Whereas, The National Park Service plays a vital role in
- 10 conserving and interpreting our nation's heritage, and through its
- 11 stewardship, these parks and historical sites serve as cultural
- 12 touchstones, connecting us to the past, present, and future of
- 13 America; and
- 14 Whereas, National Park Week encourages Michiganders and
- 15 visitors alike to explore these sites and deepen their connection
- 16 to Michigan's unique natural beauty and rich history; now,
- 17 therefore, be it
- 18 Resolved, That the members of this legislative body declare
- 19 April 19-27, 2025, as National Park Week in the state of Michigan.
- 20 We encourage all Michiganders to visit, support, and appreciate
- 21 Michigan's National Park Service sites; and be it further
- 22 Resolved, That we honor the efforts of the National Park
- 23 Service, local park rangers, volunteers, and conservation
- 24 organizations in ensuring the preservation, accessibility, and
- 25 enjoyment of these sites.
