- 9 Whereas, Irish immigrants helped form the United States'
- 10 cultural foundation. Today, those of Irish lineage proudly sing
- 11 support for Ireland; and
- 12 Whereas, The songs of Ireland are the tragic songs of love,

- 2 the glories of the Emerald Isle, the lamentations of life's myriad
- 3 travails, and the odes to joy and life eternal; and
- Whereas, We celebrate the establishment of the American Irish
- 5 State Legislators Caucus with its aim of fostering the longstanding
- 6 and equally beneficial relationship between the United States and
- 7 Ireland, with leadership in all 50 states; now, therefore, be it

- 9 body recognize March 17, 2025, as Saint Patrick's Day. We
