## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 25

Senators Daley, Bayer, Chang, Cherry, Geiss, Irwin, Klinefelt, McCann, McMorrow, Santana, Shink, Theis and Wojno offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to recognize April 2025 as Donate Life Month.
- Whereas, About 2,600 Michigan residents are currently waiting
- 3 for a life-saving organ transplant and thousands more would benefit
- 4 from tissue and corneal transplants; and
- 5 Whereas, Michigan has about 4.6 million people on the Organ
- 6 Donor Registry, and more than 42 percent of adults have not yet
- 7 registered to save and heal others; and
- 8 Whereas, The need for organ, tissue, and eye donations remains
- 9 a critical need in Michigan and in the United States; and
- 10 Whereas, Nationwide, an average of 17 people die each day
- 11 because a donated organ did not become available; and
- 12 Whereas, Organ, tissue, and eye donations can provide families

- 1 that are tragically confronted by the death of a loved one, the
- 2 comfort of knowing the gift of life provides another person with
- 3 renewed hope for a healthy life; and
- 4 Whereas, A single organ, tissue, and eye donation can save
- 5 eight lives and heal the lives of up to 125 people; and
- 6 Whereas, The act of giving the gift of life through organ,
- 7 tissue, and eye donations to someone facing imminent death, living
- 8 with blindness, or a disability is the ultimate act of generosity
- 9 and kindness; now, therefore, be it
- 10 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 11 body recognize April 2025 as Donate Life Month; and be it further
- 12 Resolved, That we encourage all residents to join the Michigan
- 13 Organ Donor Registry, share their decision with their families,
- 14 friends, and colleagues, and encourage them to do the same.
