## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 65

A resolution to declare April 2025 as Sexual Assault Awareness 1 Month in the state of Michigan. 2 3 Whereas, Sexual Assault Awareness Month calls attention to the fact that sexual violence is widespread and impacts women, 4 children, and men of all racial, cultural, and economic 5 6 backgrounds; and Whereas, The term sexual assault refers to sexual contact or 7 behavior that occurs without explicit consent of the victim; and 8 9 Whereas, According to the National Sexual Violence Resource 10 Center, one in five women in the United States experienced completed or attempted rape during their lifetime, and nearly a 11 12 quarter (24.8%) of men in the U.S. experienced some form of contact 13 sexual violence in their lifetime; and

Whereas, Child sexual abuse prevention must be a priority to

- 1 confront the reality that a Bureau of Justice statistics report in
- 2 2019 shows children between the ages of 14-17 were victims of
- 3 sexual assault; and
- 4 Whereas, Michigan State Police statistics indicate that there
- 5 were 6,823 incidents of rape that were reported to law enforcement
- 6 in 2019; and
- 7 Whereas, Sexual violence can deeply and enduringly impact
- 8 survivors on psychological, emotional, and social levels.
- 9 Approximately 68% of rape or sexual assault victims experience
- 10 moderate to severe distress, a larger percentage than for any other
- 11 violent crime studied in the National Crime Victimization Survey by
- 12 the Bureau of Justice Statistics; and
- 13 Whereas, Sexual violence is an intolerable violent crime with
- 14 public health implications for every person in Michigan. Our state
- 15 and individual communities must be committed to holding sexual
- 16 assault perpetrators accountable for their heinous crimes; and
- 17 Whereas, When we actively increase education, awareness, and
- 18 community involvement, we can help prevent sexual violence and
- 19 create a safer environment for everyone. We must work together to
- 20 educate our entire population about what can be done to prevent
- 21 sexual assault, support survivors, and ensure that survivors are
- 22 not re-victimized; now, therefore, be it
- 23 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 24 this legislative body declare April 2025 as Sexual Assault
- 25 Awareness Month in the state of Michigan. We strongly support the
- 26 efforts of national, state, and local partners, and of every
- 27 citizen to actively engage in public and private efforts to prevent
- 28 sexual violence and will take appropriate action and support one
- 29 another to create a safer environment for all.
