HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 104

Rep. Schmaltz offered the following resolution: A resolution to declare May 14, 2025, as Rail Day in the state 1 2 of Michigan. 3 Whereas, National Rail Day is celebrated in May to commemorate 4 the completion of America's first transcontinental railroad on May 5 11, 1869; and 6 Whereas, Michigan is fortunate to have 3,349 freight rail 7 miles operated by twenty-nine freight carriers and Amtrak passenger 8 service; and Whereas, Railroads are a safe way to move freight and are 9 10 working to improve infrastructure and equipment safety, reduce 11 human error, and protect the rail network every day; and 12 Whereas, Technologies like train inspection portals and 13 cracked wheel detection have resulted in accident rate reductions

of 33% since 2005; and

Whereas, Due to ongoing investments, hazmat accident rates per 1 carload have reached record lows- down 80% since 2005, and freight 2 rail remains the safest way to transport hazmat, with more than 3 99.99% of shipments arriving without a release due to a train 4 5 accident, and 6 Whereas, The railroad industry partners with law enforcement, 7 fire departments, 911 call centers, emergency management directors 8 and others to promote the Emergency Notification Sign (ENS blue 9 safety sign) which is located at every rail crossing; and 10 Whereas, Railroads offer the safety tool AskRail app to 11 Michigan's local fire and police leadership. The AskRail app provides first responders immediate access to accurate, timely data 12 about what type of hazardous materials a railcar is carrying so 13 14 they can make an informed decision about how to respond to a rail 15 emergency; and 16 Whereas, Railroads help preserve infrastructure and aid in cutting congestion. Freight railroads take 4.7 million truckloads 17 18 off Michigan roads annually; and 19 Whereas, From the auto industry and other manufacturers to 20 mining and agriculture, Michigan's productive freight rail network 21 provides key connections to keep our state's economy vibrant; now, therefore, be it 22 23 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of this legislative body declare May 14, 2025, as Rail Day in the 24 25 state of Michigan; and be it further Resolved, That we recognize and celebrate the pivotal role 26 27 that a robust freight railroad and passenger system is to the
