- 3 Whereas, Pastor Appreciation Month was established in 1922 to

- 7 Whereas, The Apostle Paul, inspired by the Holy Spirit,
- 8 charges the body of Christ to honor those who labor in preaching
- 9 and teaching as worthy of double honor; and
- 10 Whereas, Pastors admonish and teach with all wisdom, so that
- 11 Christians may reach full maturity in Christ; and
- 12 Whereas, These wise counselors declare Christ's power to the

- 2 of new and devout believers alike; and
- 3 Whereas, Pastors raise up laborers for the kingdom of God,
- 4 equipping the saints for works of ministry; exhibit the fruits of
