## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 202

Rep. Rheingans offered the following resolution: A resolution calling on the Michigan Natural Resources 1 2 Commission to temporarily extend the 2025 open firearm hunting 3 season and set the dates to be November 1, 2025, to November 30, 2025. 4 Whereas, The Michigan Department of Natural Resources has 5 established a program called Hunters Feeding Michigan which allows 6 7 deer hunters to donate venison to participating processors to be distributed to Michigan food banks. One donated deer can provide 8 approximately 160 meals for hungry Michiganders. Currently, Hunters 9 10 Feeding Michigan is completely funded by private donations; and Whereas, It has been announced that on Saturday, November 1, 11 12 2025, the United States Department of Agriculture will be pausing the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), a federal 13 14 program that helps ensure that our most vulnerable citizens stay

- 1 fed and healthy; and
- Whereas, The United States Department of Agriculture has
- 3 deemed that it is legally unable to utilize the emergency
- 4 contingency funds that have already been appropriated to the
- 5 department for SNAP. This is a complete deviation from how prior
- 6 administrations have viewed the availability of contingency funding
- 7 for SNAP during a government shutdown; and
- 8 Whereas, Stopping SNAP benefits will have drastic impacts in
- 9 Michigan and across the entire country. Approximately 1.4 million
- 10 Michiganders receive SNAP benefits, which includes 492,225 children
- 11 and 38,513 veterans; and
- 12 Whereas, Opening firearm hunting season two weeks early will
- 13 allow processors participating in Hunters Feeding Michigan to have
- 14 more time to process venison products. Such products can be frozen
- 15 and stored for later use while the country navigates these
- 16 unprecedented times; and
- 17 Whereas, While extending the open firearm season is not the
- 18 only measure that Michigan can take to make up for the lack of
- 19 federal funding for SNAP, it is one action that can help our
- 20 citizens; now, therefore, be it
- 21 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we call on the
- 22 Michigan Natural Resources Commission to temporarily extend the
- 23 2025 open firearm hunting season and set the dates to be November
- 24 1, 2025, to November 30, 2025; and be it further
- 25 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 26 Director of the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and the
- 27 members of the Michigan Natural Resources Commission.
