- 1 A resolution to recognize February 11, 2025, as the United
- 2 Auto Workers' (UAW) White Shirt Day.
- 3 Whereas, We recognize Michigan's members of the United Auto
- 4 Workers (UAW) as they gather to mark the 88th anniversary of their
- 5 first contract with General Motors. This anniversary is a
- 6 reflection of the extreme sacrifice, commitment, and determination
- 7 of those first UAW members who paved the way for higher pay and
- 8 improved benefits, creating a positive atmosphere for all of
- 9 America's working men and women. We remember those historic members
- 10 on this anniversary; and
- 11 Whereas, On February 11, 2025, UAW members and retirees will
- 12 wear white shirts to commemorate the anniversary of the end of the

- 1 famous Flint Sit-Down Strike in 1937. While the members of this
- 2 distinguished organization celebrate this event, we offer our
- 3 thanks for the outstanding contributions made to the Flint
- 4 community, our state, and our nation; and
- 5 Whereas, The origin of the UAW's White Shirt Day can be traced
- 6 back to 1948 when Bert Christensen, a UAW member of Local 598,
- 7 first suggested it. His idea was to ask that workers wear the white
- 8 shirts traditionally worn by managers to show the company that they
- 9 were equally important to the business. The shirts represent equal
- 10 respect and treatment for blue-collar workers and the unity and
- 11 strength of UAW members; and
- 12 Whereas, With ceremonies to celebrate its history, the members
- 13 and officers of the UAW will remember the vision of its founders
- 14 and the commitment of its workers that have brought them to this
- 15 point. Fittingly, as they look to the past, they will also be
- 16 casting an eye to the future and the many ways in which United Auto
- 17 Workers will continue to serve the working men and women of this
- 18 great country; now, therefore, be it
- 19 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 20 body recognize February 11, 2025, as the United Auto Workers' (UAW)
- 21 White Shirt Day. We commemorate the 88th anniversary of the first
- 22 United Auto Workers contract with General Motors and everyone who
- 23 has contributed to its success; and be it further
- 24 Resolved, That we applaud their accomplishments and thank them
- 25 for helping to strengthen and build Michigan's communities,
- 26 workforce, and economy.
