SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 15

Senator Chang offered the following resolution: A resolution to commemorate March 2025 as Social Work Month. 1 Whereas, People have entered the social work profession for 2 3 generations because they genuinely care about helping improve the welfare of people, families, communities and our nation; and 4 5 Whereas, This year's social work month theme, "Social Work: Compassion + Action," embodies the fact that social workers go 6 7 through years of education and training, so they have the skills and expertise to transform their care for others into action that 8 9 brings positive results; and 10 Whereas, The social work profession has worked for generations to improve living conditions in our nation, with social workers 11 12 successfully pushing for Social Security, a 40-hour work week, 13 Medicare, and a minimum wage; and 14 Whereas, Social workers have helped this nation live up to its 2

- 1 values by successfully advocating for equal rights for all people,
- 2 no matter their race, sexual identity, gender, gender expression,
- 3 culture, or religion; and
- 4 Whereas, Social workers follow a code of ethics, which sets
- 5 the primary mission of enhancing human well-being and meeting the
- 6 basic human needs of all people, with particular attention to the
- 7 needs and empowerment of those who are vulnerable, oppressed, and
- 8 living in poverty; and
- 9 Whereas, In the United States, social work is one of the
- 10 fastest growing professions, with more than 800,000 people expected
- 11 to be employed as social workers by 2033; and
- 12 Whereas, There are more than 30,000 licensed social workers in
- 13 the state of Michigan alone, while 6,500 social work students are
- 14 slated to join the workforce; and
- 15 Whereas, Social workers work in all parts of our society -
- 16 including schools, social service agencies, veteran centers, and
- 17 government helping people, families, and communities secure
- 18 services and policies they need to thrive; and
- 19 Whereas, They are also at the forefront of pressing issues our
- 20 nation is addressing, including increased needs for mental health
- 21 care, especially for children and adolescents, substance use
- 22 disorder treatment, and increased economic and political division;

- 24 Whereas, Social workers are one of the largest groups of
- 25 mental health care providers in the United States and are pushing
- 26 for a Social Work Interstate Licensing Compact that will improve
- 27 mental health care delivery in our nation; and
- 28 Whereas, They help protect millions of children from abuse and
- 29 neglect and provide services and support, which help strengthen

- 1 families that are under stress, and help create new families
- 2 through adoption; and
- 3 Whereas, Research proves that social workers in schools,
- 4 hospitals, and assisted living facilities improve education and
- 5 health outcomes, as well as the quality of life for students,
- 6 patients, and residents; and
- 7 Whereas, Social workers stand ready to assist our nation in
- 8 overcoming present and future challenges, including ending gun
- 9 violence, improving health care and mental health care for all, and
- 10 urging lawmakers to adopt immigration reforms; now, therefore, be

- 12 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 13 body commemorate March 2025 as Social Work Month; and be it further
- 14 Resolved, That in recognition of the numerous contributions
- 15 made by America's social workers, we call upon all citizens to join
- 16 the National Association of Social Workers in celebrating Social
- 17 Work Month.
