SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 84

Senator Damoose offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the sinking of the S.S. Edmund Fitzgerald. 2 3 Whereas, On November 10, 1975, the Great Lakes freighter S.S. 4 Edmund Fitzgerald, one of the largest and most storied vessels ever to sail the inland seas, sank during a fierce storm on Lake 5 Superior, taking with it all 29 brave souls aboard; and 6 Whereas, The loss of the Edmund Fitzgerald remains the 7 deadliest tragedy in Great Lakes shipping history, a solemn 8 9 reminder of both the power of nature and the courage of those who 10 dedicate their lives to maritime commerce; and Whereas, The men who perished that night were fathers, sons, 11 12 brothers, and friends - hardworking crewmen who embodied the grit, 13 perseverance, and devotion that define Michigan's maritime 14 heritage; and

1 Whereas, The 29 men lost on the Edmund Fitzgerald join more

2 than 30,000 mariners who are estimated to have perished throughout

- 3 history on the Great Lakes; and
- 4 Whereas, The sinking of the Edmund Fitzgerald spurred
- 5 improvements in maritime safety, leading to stronger regulations,
- 6 enhanced ship design, and advanced weather monitoring, ensuring
- 7 that the sacrifice of her crew contributed to greater protections
- 8 for future generations; and
- 9 Whereas, For five decades, the memory of the Edmund Fitzgerald
- 10 has been honored in Michigan and across the Great Lakes through
- 11 solemn ceremonies, tolling church bells, and story telling that
- 12 keeps a living legacy of those lost; and
- 13 Whereas, The people of Michigan remain forever bound to the
- 14 waters of the Great Lakes, which have shaped our history, culture,
- 15 and economy, and on this solemn anniversary we reaffirm our
- 16 enduring respect for those who work and sacrifice upon them; now,
- 17 therefore, be it
- 18 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 19 body commemorate the 50th anniversary of the sinking of the S.S.
- 20 Edmund Fitzgerald and pay tribute to the memory of her 29 crew
- 21 members, whose lives were tragically lost on November 10, 1975; and
- 22 be it further
- Resolved, That November 10, 2025 will be recognized as "Edmund
- 24 Fitzgerald Day" in honor of the mariners lost in that tragic event;
- 25 and be it further
- 26 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 27 families of the crew, maritime organizations, and museums dedicated
- 28 to preserving the history of the Great Lakes as a lasting testament
- 29 to Michigan's reverence for the Edmund Fitzgerald and her crew.
