

STATE SYMBOL FOR CLEAN WATER
Act 78 of 2004

AN ACT to designate an official state symbol for clean water in this state.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

2.18 State symbol for clean water.

Sec. 1. The American lotus blossom (*Nelumbo lutea*) is designated as the official state symbol for clean water in this state.

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
