

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS IN POLICE OR PEACE OFFICERS' VEHICLES
Act 211 of 1964

AN ACT to provide for the carrying of fire extinguishers in police and peace officers' vehicles.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

29.351 Police or peace officers' vehicles; fire extinguishers.

Sec. 1. A state or county owned police or peace officers' vehicle shall carry a dry chemical type fire extinguisher listed by and bearing the label of a nationally recognized testing laboratory and containing not less than 4 pounds of extinguishing agent, which shall be inspected at least annually by the local fire department.

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
