## MICHIGAN ELECTION LAW (EXCERPT) Act 116 of 1954

## 168.13 Time limits; extension due to holiday, exception.

Sec. 13.

- (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the contrary, and except as otherwise provided under subsection (2), anything required by this act to be done by a day certain, if that day falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, may be done within the same time limits on the next secular day.
  - (2) This section does not apply to either of the following:
  - (a) The final day for applying for an absent voter ballot.
  - (b) Any deadline provided for under section 845a.
