257.43a.added "Preliminary roadside analysis" defined.

Sec. 43a. "Preliminary roadside analysis" means the on-site taking of a preliminary breath test from the breath of a person or the performance and observation of a field sobriety test for the purpose of detecting the presence of any of the following within the person's body:

- (a) Alcoholic liquor.
- (b) A controlled substance, as that term is defined in section 7104 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7104.
 - (c) Any other intoxicating substance, as that term is defined in section 625.
 - (d) Any combination of the substances listed in subdivisions (a) to (c).
