## SAFE DRINKING WATER ACT (EXCERPT) Act 399 of 1976

325.1021 Violation as misdemeanor; penalty; issuance of appearance ticket; "minor offense" defined.

Sec. 21.

- (1) A person who violates this act or the rules promulgated under this act or an order issued pursuant to this act is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for each day of violation, or by imprisonment for not more than 1 year, or both.
- (2) A law enforcement officer may issue and serve an appearance ticket upon a person for a minor offense pursuant to sections 9c to 9g of chapter IV of the code of criminal procedure, 1927 PA 175, MCL 764.9c to  $764.9\sigma$
- (3) As used in this section, "minor offense" means a violation of a permit issued under this act that does not functionally impair the operation or capacity of a waterworks system or the level of public health protection it provides.
