

EDUCATION OF CHILDREN OF VETERANS (EXCERPT)
Act 245 of 1935

35.111a “Michigan veteran” defined.

Sec. 1a. As used in this act, “Michigan veteran” means a person whose legal residence immediately before entering service was in this state. A veteran who did not have legal residence in this state before entering the military service shall be considered a Michigan veteran for purposes of this act after having established a legal residence in this state. A veteran whose legal residence was in this state before entering military service shall not be considered a Michigan veteran for purposes of this act if the person leaves this state for more than 2 years.
