388.1813.added Statewide reverse transfer agreements.

Sec. 213. It is the intent of the legislature that community colleges work with public universities in the state to implement statewide reverse transfer agreements to increase the number of students that are awarded credentials of value upon completion of the necessary credits. In doing so, the institutions should work collaboratively and cooperatively to remove administrative barriers that result in understating the academic attainment of Michigan's citizens. It is the intent of the legislature that by August 1, 2012, statewide agreements be in place between community colleges and public universities that enable students who have earned a significant number of credits at a community college and transfer to a baccalaureate-granting institution before completing a degree to transfer the credits earned at the baccalaureate institution back to the community college in order to be awarded a credential of value.
