388.1872a.amended Rejection of transfer credits; report by public university.

Sec. 272a. By February 15, of each year, each public university receiving funds under section 236 shall submit a report to the house and senate appropriations subcommittees on higher education, the house and senate fiscal agencies, and the state budget director regarding the rejection of transfer credits by the university in the prior year. The report shall include information on the number of credits earned by incoming resident students at other postsecondary institutions in this state, with the equivalent of a letter grade of C or higher, that were rejected by the university for transfer, reported by both academic program area and prior institution, along with explanatory information regarding the rationale for the rejection of the credits. Data may be reported on either an academic or calendar year basis.
