400.118 Youth advisory commission; creation; appointment, qualifications, terms, and compensation of members.

Sec. 118.

- (1) A youth advisory commission is created within the office to consist of 7 members appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate. Not more than 4 of the members shall be from the same political party. Members shall be appointed for terms of 4 years and shall serve until their successors are appointed and qualified.
- (2) The per diem compensation of the advisory commission and the schedule for reimbursement of expenses shall be established annually by the legislature.
